

Sno Kone Machine Operating Instructions

1. Set the machine on a table or level surface. Make sure to put the drain hose over a bucket or other area that can accept any draining liquid from the machine. Melted ice and condensation go into the drain hose.
2. Plug in machine. Using an extension cord may result in a loss of power to the machine.
3. Turn on light switch (located on front of cabinet). Light will come on in cabinet.
4. Turn on the motor button or for some models **Push** and hold the motor button.
5. Wait for the motor to come to full speed.
6. Fill the chute to within an inch of the top with ice cubes or block ice. The larger the pieces, the better the sno. The Sno Kone Machine can take ice cubes or blocks of ice broken into pieces approximately 3" - 4" in size. The ice will not fit in the shaver if the pieces are too large.
7. Push the pusher handle down against the ice in the chute. Apply firm and even pressure to make the best sno (too much pressure will result in snow that is coarse; too little pressure will make the snow mushy).
8. Repeat steps 3 - 6 until you have enough shaved ice.
9. Scoop out enough shaved ice to fill a serving cone and pump 2 to 3 squirts of flavor onto the shaved ice. Enjoy!

Sno Kone Machine Cleaning Instructions

1. Wipe all water and any syrup off of the cabinet inside and out.
2. Clean the Ladle, Ice Scoop, and Syrup Pump(s).
3. **Make sure to return the Sno Kone Machine clean, in order to be refunded your cleaning deposit.**
